Dear Parents and Carers,

The weather has certainly turned wintry this week and with this in mind I would like to remind you of our procedure for unexpected closure due to bad weather. If it is snowing heavily in Northallerton and you think the school may be closed, please do **not** ring school before 8.20am to allow the phone to be free for the staff to call in and report their situation. Most of our teaching staff live a good distance from school and while the weather/road conditions in Northallerton may be ok, staff could be experiencing much worse conditions on their route to school. As soon as a decision is made, we will send a text message to parents and post the closure on our website and twitter. Should the school have to close early because of bad weather, parents will be contacted by text or telephone.

In assemblies his week I have reminded the children about the importance of wearing appropriate clothing for the current cold weather. Warm coats, hats, scarves and gloves are needed please as we play and learn outside in all but the most inclement weather.

We are hoping this very cold spell will kill off all the nasty bugs that have been going around school. As you will see from our attendance report, many children have been affected. Please can I remind you that if your child has sickness and/or diarrhoea they must not come back to school until 48 hours have passed since the last episode of sickness or diarrhoea.
