Miss Smith's class with parents from 12.20

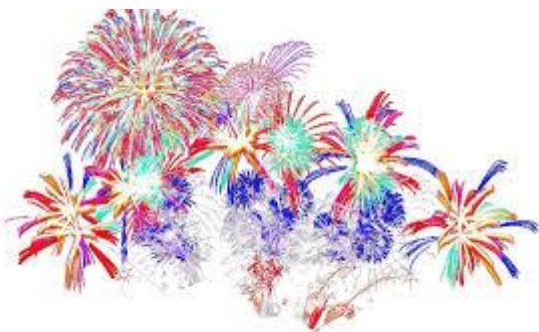
Miss Roberts' class with parents from 12.30
