ASSESSMENT WEEK

Next week will see children from Year 2 to Year 5 completing some end of term assessments in grammar, reading and maths. Year 6 have already been busy with their own assessments this week. Please reassure children that the purpose of these is a chance to show off all the brilliant skills they developed this term: we know with a positive attitude and being ready to do their best we're sure the children will do fantastically!

CONSULTATION ON BROOMFIELD NURSERY

As you may be aware, as part of our development as a school and with the backing of Arete, we are beginning the process of lowering the school age at Broomfield Primary so that we can provide school-led nursey provision. As part of this process, there will be a consultation period from 29/11/24 to 20/12/24. Responses to the proposal are welcomed before a final decision can be made on submitting the application for the nursery. You will find the full consultation document on Dojo and also the school website, which includes all the details and how to respond.

ARETE LEARNING TRUST

This Monday saw the first visit to Broomfield from the trustees of Arete. The three visitors focused on behaviour and attitudes, spending time talking to staff, children, leadership and taking part in a learning walk around school. The trustees were impressed with the calm, focused and supportive feel around school and commented upon how well-mannered, invested in the school and caring children seemed in their pupil voice responses. We are looking forward to future work with the trust in supporting and moving the school forward.

ATTENDANCE SLIPS

As mentioned previously in the weekly newsletter, we now receive weekly slips from the Arete trust to update parents about their children's attendance. These will be given out weekly for children to bring home in book bags for children who are at risk due to being below 90% attendance. As we have previously mentioned, consistent good attendance is vital to support your child in making the progress they need in school. Below is an example of what the slips look like.

90% attendance means four school weeks missed per year, which is half a year over five years. The DfE classifies any child with attendance below 90% as a persistent absentee. Broomfield aims to work alongside our families to help with attendance.

My attendance for school year 2023/24 was: 92.5%

PARKING

Unfortunately, we are still seeing several issues with regard to collection of children when parking in the car park and around school. Firstly, please ensure that when using the car park that you don't arrive too early. With Sacred Heart School finishing at 3.10pm, this is causing congestion. Please aim to arrive after 3.10pm to avoid this and be in time for our finish time of 3.20pm. Also, we have been informed that some people are double parking on the roads around school at pick-up time, which is increasing congestion and making the roads unsafe. Please take care to ensure roads are clear and there are no obstructions if parking nearby to school. Thank you.

CLOAKROOMS

We have noticed around school that cloakrooms are becoming rather cluttered! With some classes having large numbers this can make the corridors around school rather messy, leading to children losing items or there being trip hazards. Please can we ask that you minimise the size of bag and amount of 'luggage' your children are bringing to school. We understand that thicker coats, hats and gloves are needed at this time of year, but additionally children should only need their book bag or a similar sized bag and a packed lunch if needed. Thank you.

FOBS CHRISTMAS FAIR

Next Thursday after school we are very excited to welcome everyone to the Friends of Broomfield School Christmas Fair. The children have all been busy creating festive crafts, goodies and games in their classes for you to purchase and raise money for the school.
