## **PARENT TEACHER CONSULTATION EVENINGS**

Parent Consultation evenings are Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> October and Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> October. This is an opportunity to speak to your child's class teacher and see how they have settled into their class. Please sign your child's name next to an appointment time on the sign-up sheet. These can be found on the classroom doors where your child exits school, with the exception of Reception: your sign-up sheet is in the school entrance porch. If you have more than one child in school, please ensure you leave a 10-minute gap between appointments in case a teacher is running late.

If your child has an Individual Provision Map (IPM), the class teacher will have been in contact with you via Dojo to make an appointment next week, rather than consultation week, so that the IPM can be reviewed. This is <u>instead</u> of attending an appointment on the  $15^{th}/17^{th}$ .

At each evening, the front door of school will be open. Please enter via this door and take a seat in the hall. A bell will be rung every 10 minutes to help people keep to time. Please then go to your child's classroom for your allocated time. I will also be available on both evenings, sat in the hall, should anyone like to speak to me.
